Highly dynamic and personalised photo presentation/ displays for funerals, birthdays or any event.

Tips to plan for your loved one's photo display video.

- Collect pictures/video from family and friends.

You may have a lot of pictures of your own, but it's a great idea to invite others to share anything they have too. You may discover moments and experiences you'd forgotten, or you didn't know about. It also helps the family feel a part of the process.

- How many photos to use in a funeral slideshow?

We believe there's a real value in selecting the pictures to use in your funeral slideshow, with close family members. This shared moment of reflection can be beneficial in processing your grief. It can spark conversation and help to share special moments that ease the pain. Think about the content and mood of the pictures, preferencing those that have a focus on your loved one for the funeral video.

- How long should the funeral video be?

Funeral videos are an amazing way to help tell the story of a loved one. While the length of the video is entirely up to you, but you do not want to flash the photos up too quickly. We recommend that 6-7 seconds is about the right length and would never go faster than 5 seconds.

- How to select and order your photos for a funeral video?

We believe there's a real value in selecting the pictures to use in your funeral slideshow, with close family members. Aim to tell a story with your selected photos. This could be ordering the pictures in chronological order or grouping them into themes or moments, different stages of a person's life, a written guide can be beneficial.

- How many photos and video will you need?

Totally up to you, but a minimum of 20-30 or more should be enough to construct a photo display video.

30 photos at 5 - 6 seconds duration each will produce a 3-minute photo display video. Depending what video, you might want to add will lengthen the video. Short grabs of video are far more effective.

- Picking appropriate music for the photo display

Music plays an important role in a funeral video for setting the tone and expressing the personality of your loved one. Adding their favourite song creates a very personal touch. I will try to time the images with the flow of the music. It need not be music, sound effects can be very effective: bird sounds or the sound of the ocean/waves may suit the photo display video.
